We now have an opening for a LMSW, bilingual English/Spanish preferred, Social Worker to be Director of CEMAPP – *Community Elder Mistreatment and Abuse Prevention Program*. This crisis intervention elder abuse program provides services to older adults and their families in Central & Northern Manhattan. The Director of Elder Abuse will report directly to the Associate Director. As a member of the Executive Team this Director works closely with other Directors in program planning and represents the agency in community and interagency activities.

The Director of Elder Abuse must be flexible and able to thrive working independently.

Responsibilities include:

- supervise Elder Abuse Social Worker
- provide crisis intervention counseling
- carry a case load including making home visits
- prepare quantitative and qualitative reports for CEMAPP funding sources.
- review case records, care plans and monthly statistics of CEMAPP staff
- act as liaison to other elder abuse programs in New York City
- coordinate development and delivery of community education and training sessions for seniors and professionals
- client advocacy, especially with the police, court, and medical systems, is a major component of our work.

Qualifications:

The Director of Elder Abuse must be a mature leader with three years of geriatric, domestic violence or elder abuse social work experience.
